INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPIDER BLIND

STEP #1



Remove Spider Blind from carrying bag

STEP #2



Unfold Spider Blind

STEP #3



Attach tree strap around tree and adjust for tree size

When positioning this blind, always carefully consider the possibility of falling rocks or tree limbs, lightning strikes, flash floods, avalanches, strong winds and other objective hazards. Always use the included anchors to secure the blind to the ground.

STEP #4



Attach stakes in the desired loop on the Spider Blind leg and then stake in the ground. Repeat for the remaining Spider Blind legs.

STEP #5



Blind is now ready for use.

To remove Spider Blind reverse Steps #1-4

IMPORTANT: BEFORE take-down of your **Spider Blind**, remove all high wind tie-downs and ground stakes. Make sure that it is **COMPLETELY DRY** and free from dirt and any debris.

NEVER USE A HEATER IN YOUR SPIDER BLIND

NEVER ALLOW ANYONE TO USE LIGHTED CANDLES, MATCHES OR OTHER SOURCES OF FIRE NEAR THIS PRODUCT

NEVER EXPOSE YOUR BLIND TO ANY OPEN FLAME. THIS PRODUCT IS NOT FIREPROOF

NEVER SHOOT THROUGH ANY PART OF THE SPIDER BLIND WITH A FIREARM SPARKS OR FLAMES COULD IGNITE THE MATERIAL

WHEN SHOOTING AN ARROW FROM THE SPIDER BLIND BE SURE NO PART OF THE ARROW COMES INTO CONTACT WITH ANY PART OF THE BLIND

NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY WITH THIS PRODUCT

NEVER ALLOW MATERIAL TO COVER FACE. IT CAN CAUSE SUFFOCATION AND DEATH

Storage and Tips: Store your blind in a cool dry place- free native brush, dirt and any debris
Never store your Spider Blind wet or damp; Avoid leaving your blind outdoors for any extended period of time

UV (ULTRAVIOLET LIGHT) WARNING:

Ultraviolet light breaks down lightweight fabric fibers and almost any synthetic material. The material will fade (discolor), lose strength and eventually disintegrate if left in prolonged sunlight. To extend the life of your Spider Blind avoid leaving in direct sunlight. Set up you Spider Blind in a shady spot whenever possible to extend your blinds life.
